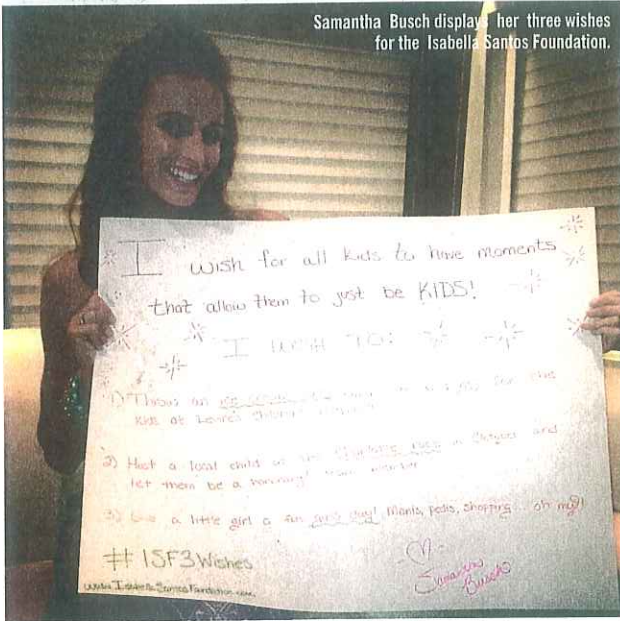

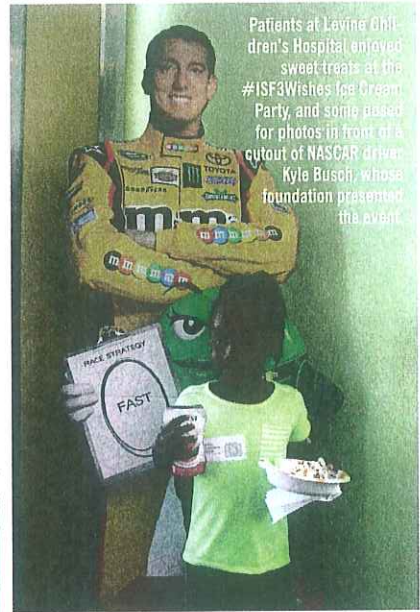
Isabella Santos Foundation
