FUNDING LEVELS

\$25,000 | Clinical Research

Five gifts at this level will fully fund one year of neuroblastoma and osteosarcoma research at Children's Hospital of Atlanta, driving progress for bone and nerve cell cancer.

\$20,000 | Immediate Local Impact

Five gifts at this level fund a year of the Live My Dreams program at Atrium Health, delivering urgent, vital support to local families.

\$15,000 | Clinical Research

Six gifts at this level fund one year of CAR T-cell research at UNC-Chapel Hill, advancing treatments for rare brain tumors.

\$10,000 | Mental Health

Eight gifts at this level provide one year of bi-weekly outpatient mental health counseling sessions for 16 children at partner hospitals.

\$5,000 | Nourishment

Ten gifts at this level fund one year of whole-foods-based healthy meals for 20 children undergoing chemotherapy.

\$2,500 | Science

Twelve gifts at this level will drive scientific advances in rhabdomyosarcoma, unlocking new treatments at MUSC Shawn Jenkins Children's Hospital.
